
R.E. Focus	Christianity: What did Jesus teach?	Year 2	Autumn 1
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What? (Key Knowledge)

Jesus' kindness	Christians believe Jesus could be kind to everyone because God was helping Him. They believe He is God on earth.
The Good Samaritan	One of Jesus' most important teachings was 'Love your neighbour as yourself' (Mark 12:28-31). Jesus meant everyone is your neighbour so you should love everybody the same.
The story of Jesus healing the Paralysed Man	Jesus was kind to the paralysed man, He helped him walk again. This meant he could make a new start in life.
Christian daily life	Christians believe they should help others make the best of their lives too. People from the Salvation Army are kind because they give food to homeless people. Jesus would be proud of Christians who behave like this.

- Outdoor Learning – Re-enact one of the parables and perform on the outdoor stage.
