**Publicity Secretaries** - Jenny Archer and Mrs K Boost

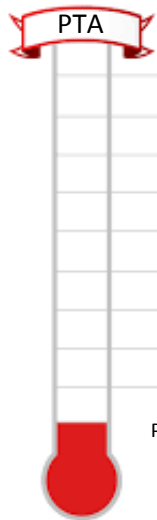
