While we await some final published results, our Year 4 children have performed exceptionally well in the Times Table Check, achieving significantly above both local and national averages. Across the school, outcomes in Early Years, Phonics, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 assessments are in line with or above national benchmarks. Notably, the proportion of pupils working at the 'Greater Depth' standard, which indicates higher attainment for their age, is above national figures. These results reflect the commitment and hard work of our pupils and staff alike.

As we look ahead to a new school year, it was a pleasure to welcome pupils to their new classrooms and teachers during our recent 'Meet the Teacher Day.' The excitement is already building.

To be eligible for Pupil Premium, families should be in receipt of the following:

- Income support
- Income based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (providing you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit), with a gross annual household income of no more than £16,190 (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs-HMRC)
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment received for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit, with a net annual household income of £7,400 or less (after tax and not including any other benefits you receive).
