Science	PDF – class page BBC and YouTube links Materials to represent day and night	<u>WALT: explain day and night and the apparent movement of the Sun across the sky</u> Think: How do we have day and night on planet Earth? Watch the following videos which animates the rotation of the Earth. http://www.bbc.co.uk/learningzone/clips/day-and-night/1874.html https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zkynvcw Write a brief description about what you have learnt. Challenge: Can you make your own model to demonstrate your learning? E.g. Plasticene person on a globe. Shine torch at the globe whilst rotating it. The ‘person’ will pass through day and night. Or, make Earth by using a white polystyrene ball with a piece of wooden dowelling placed through it. Again, stick on person, shine torch and rotate the ball.

What do you think you would need to take on a climb up the mountains to ensure that they had prepared for any eventuality? Write a letter to a friend giving them advice as to what they need to take on a mountain climb.
