		<ul> <li>With the photographs printed label the pictures and write a short paragraph about why plastic would have been chosen for each item.</li> </ul>			
History/ Geography	PowerPoint presentation Wanted poster Key word mat	<ul> <li>To ask and answer questions, choosing and using parts of stories and other sources to show that they know and understand key features of events and to find out about events beyond living memory that are significant nationally by learning about what happened directly after the Gunpowder Plot</li> <li>Work through this week's Power Point and talk through the events of what happened after Guy Fawkes had been caught. Explain that he tried to protect his co-conspirators by giving a false name. As Thomas Percy was one of the king's bodyguards, it was easy to trace the plot back to him.</li> <li>Thomas Percy, along with Robert Catesby and the other plotters, fled London and tried to recruit more supporters to help them. In the end they were either caught or captured at Holbeche House.</li> <li>The survivors were executed in January 1606 at the Tower of London.</li> <li>Children to create a wanted poster for Thomas Percy or Robert Catesby.</li> </ul>
