		- Work through the week 6 Power Point
		 At home find a small plastic container and create a hole in the bottom.
		 Find a few different materials from home that can be used to plug the hole such as- playdoh, cotton wool, tin foil, plastic bag and test them at blocking the hole.
		 Children to measure the amount of water that goes into the container, and then measure the amount of water that passes through the hole.

		 Using the recording sheet children can draw an image of each material they used to block the hole and measure how much water gets through.
