Record and Impact of Spending for 2020 – 2021 PE Sport Grant

Objective	Impact	Actual cost
Swimming	<p>Due to Covid, swimming lessons commenced for the Summer term only. Year 6 have had a full term of swimming teaching (summer). All other classes have had half a term. The quality of swimming teaching during this period has remained high.</p> <p>Whilst we have not been able to match the consistency of teaching over the past two years; progress has been made in the short time available for swimming. The quality teaching sustained over the past three years has resulted in all year 6 children being able to swim at least 25m. Year groups coming up are in a strong position to achieve the same by the end of Year 6.</p> <p>“I am more confident in the water now. I can swim further than I could before” JW</p> <p>The infrastructure remains established for us to continue this high level quality teaching (£7, 500).</p>	<p>Budget Contribution towards Salary £7,500</p> <p>Actual £7500</p>

Competitive Sports	<p>Covid had a massive impact on competitive sporting events. However, we participated in virtual competitions through our membership with Your School Games. Through this, opportunity has been given to children of all sporting abilities to develop skills and confidence remotely, whilst still competing against others.</p> <p>We would have competed in cross country, cricket and athletic competitions had it not been for Covid 19.</p> <p>We have not received the value of the £642 this year, but for us to access all competitive sports across Bromley this coming year, this is essential.</p>	<p>Budget £500</p> <p>Actual £450</p>
Football Teams	<p>This year the planned coaching for football teams and representation in football leagues was not realised, due to Covid restrictions. However, as soon as Skills Academy were allowed to return to school and provide coaching, they have delivered high quality coaching, with a focus on ball skills, to all of Year 5 & 6. This has been for the summer term. The impact of this was fewer behaviour issues, children were more active and were exposed to good role models.</p> <p>In addition, money not spent on football coaching, was used to provide a whole school remote dance programme, to support the schools 'Get back – Get fit' initiative, following the children's return to school after the last lock down. This was inclusive for all children and supported CPD of teachers. This was provided by Skills Academy.</p>	<p>Budget £3150</p> <p>Actual spent £1400</p>

Resourcing and Kit	<p>We have purchased a new football kit and netball bibs for general PE lessons. Without having competitive sports this year, it has not been a priority to purchase additional kit, however, our intention is to do this in September.</p> <p>Staff PE tops will also be purchased in September. The money put aside for this will be carried over to the following year.</p>	<p>Budget was £2850</p> <p>Actual spent only recently put through £331.20</p>
Playground markings	<p>Quotes have been acquired for this work to be completed; we are currently in the process of setting dates for this to be done. There is some tarmac repairs to be done before we can go ahead with this.</p> <p>Again, the funds for this project have been put aside to be carried over to next year.</p>	<p>Budget was £3000</p> <p>Actual spent nothing as can't go ahead until playground repaired.</p> <p>But we have quotes invoices ranging from £3000 - £5000 and would like to do</p>
Replacing nets	<p>Still need to replace nets for football posts but other nets have been provided and replaced through PTA funding</p>	<p>Budget was £2000</p> <p>Actual spend nothing</p>
