## What? (Key Knowledge)

The Nativity Scene

In the Christian tradition, a **nativity scene** is a special exhibition that represents the birth of Jesus, as told in the Bible. The Nativity scene is also known as the manger scene or the crib. The scene takes place in Bethlehem.

Modern day Christmas traditions

Some modern day traditions include giving presents, Christmas crackers, Christmas trees, Christmas cards, holly wreaths, parties, decorations, turkey and Father Christmas.

Does the birth of Jesus have a place in modern day Christmas celebrations?

Singing carols, angels, stars, the Christingle, the Nativity scene and Advent are all traditions that are reminiscent of the birth of Christ.

### Spelling

**Incarnation**

### Definition

**Incarnation**, central Christian doctrine that God became flesh, that God assumed a human nature and became a man in the form of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

Resurrection

**Resurrection**, the rising from the dead of a divine or human being who still retains his own personhood, or individuality, though the body may or may not be changed.

**Celebration**

An action that commemorates an important day or event

Tradition

The passing down of beliefs or customs through the generations.

- Take a walk of the local area and look at some of the Christmas decorations. Are these relevant to the birth of Jesus? Would you argue that they are still traditional?
