


# Welcome to Year 3 Dragonflies Class!

Miss Parrott and Mrs Boost are available most afternoons after school to address any questions you may have, or you can make an appointment with the office. Please do make use of ClassDojo for general queries. It can also be used to update the adults of absences, but the office still needs to be contacted telephonically.



## **Curriculum:**

Our class page will have regular updates of our weekly and termly learning, which will also include photos. On our class page you will also find our timetable. In order to ensure that children get the most out of the curriculum, we ask that they bring in their PE kit. The PE kit will need to include shorts, blue T-shirt, spare socks, trainers, plimsolls, tracksuit/jogging bottoms and top for outside. Please ensure that ALL items of clothing are labelled.

## **Reading and Homework:**

Homework is given out every Friday and should be returned every Wednesday. Each week the children will have English work to complete, times tables to practice and a page of their maths homework book to complete. Children will also be given a piece of curriculum homework to do, which is optional every other week. Children are given dojos if they complete homework, and a homework of the week will be chosen to go on display. Children that do not complete and hand in their homework on Wednesday will have to attend Homework club on Thursday.

We ask that children read at home every night. This is not compulsory, however children will receive a dojo for every night that they do read. You do not have to read with your child, but we do recommend that you oversee your child reading and leave a comment in your child's reading record. Please let us know if the book that your child has chosen is not suitable for their reading level. All reading records should be signed by an adult and not the child.

## **Reminders:**

Children need to bring in a water bottle, jumper and raincoat on a daily basis whatever the weather. They will have access to their water bottles throughout the day and they may also need their raincoat, especially since our curriculum has an emphasis on outdoor learning. It is very important that children bring in a book bag every day as this will help that letters, books, reading journals and homework books don't go missing.
